5. <u>Essential Documents Required During Rally (Original with minimum three photocopies).</u>

(a) Educational Certificate.

- (i) <u>Soldier General Duty & Soldier Clerk/SKT</u>. Original Mark sheet of Class 10th / 12th or higher education. Candidates studied from NIOS, required to produce transfer cert (TC) of class 8th duly countersigned by the respective District Education Officer to authenticate its correctness, Mark Sheet downloaded from computer must be signed by concerned school principal. All mark sheets produced will also be verified by the Education Board for which the selected candidates are requested to deposit requisite fees with the education board.
- (b) <u>Permanent Residence / Nativity / Domicile Certificate</u>. Permanent Residence / Nativity / Domicile certificate duly signed and issued by Naib Tehsildar / Tehsildar / SDM (C).
- (c) <u>Dogra Class Certificate</u>. Dogra class certificate duly signed and issued by Naib Tehsildar / Tehsildar / SDM (C).
- (d) <u>Caste Certificate</u>. All candidates will produce caste certificate duly signed by Tehsildar / SDM / DM. **SIKH & SIKH (M&R) candidates** will also produce caste certificate of their father duly signed and issued by Tehsildar / SDM/DM alongwith their caste certificate.
- (e) <u>Character Certificate</u>. Character Certificate duly signed by the Village Sarpanch & should be within 06 Months from date of rally.
- (f) <u>Aadhar Card, PAN Card & Savings Bank Acct</u>. All candidates are must in possession of Original and 03 x Photocopies of Aadhar Card, PAN Card and Pass Book of Savings Bank Acct or at least should have applied for the same (Copy of receipt should be produced).
- 6. **Photographs**. 12 recent coloured passport size photographs showing both the ears of the candidate with name and date of birth printed on the photographs and attested by village sarpanch on **reverse** of the photographs. Different size of photographs/ scanned photographs / attested in front of photos, will not be accepted. SIKH and SIKH (M&R) candidates photographs should be with turban /Putka and he should also carry two joint photographs in turban with his parents.
- 7. Relationship Certificate. Son of Servicemen/Ex- Servicemen / Widows/War Widows have to produce Discharge Book and Original Relation Certificate, issued by Chief Record Officer / Senior Record Officer.
- 8. Candidate below the age of 18 years should bring the certificate duly signed by the parents (Father/ Mother)/ guardian and attested by village sarpanch stating that the " I am sending my Son Name ______ Date of Birth_____ for recruitment in Army on my own interest and there is no objection on him joining the Army".
- 9. Candidate aged 21 / below 21 years of age should bring unmarried certificate duly signed by self, father / mother / guardian & countersigned by village sarpanch.

- 10. NCC certificate holders / Sports certificate holders should produce original certificate. **Sports certificate should not be more than two years old**.
- 11. O + level computer certificate issued by the DOEACC for Sol Clk/SKT, If any.
- 12. <u>Photocopies of All Documents</u>. All candidates must carry minimum **03 x photocopies of all above documents alongwith original documents**.

13. Instructions.

- (a) **Permanent body tattoos** are only permitted on inner aspect of forearm i.e. from inside of elbow to the wrist and on the reverse side of palm/back (dorsal) side of hand. Permanent body tattoos on any other part of the body are not acceptable and candidates will be barred from further selection. Tribes with tattoo marks on the face or body as per their existing custom and traditions will be permitted on a case to case basis.
- (b) Use of Mobile Phones are NOT allowed inside the rally site & Written Exam premises.
- (c) Producing of fake documents & giving false info will make you liable for termination of service in spite of any number of years service you may render.
- (d) Candidate /Father/Mother/Relative of candidate will not have any rights for claiming compensation or to hold Indian Govt / Indian Army responsible for any injury/ disease /disability suffered during the various physical tests undergone by the candidate at the time of recruitment.
